

Your baby's body begins with a single cell and grows to 3 trillion cells before birth. Then, the cells increase to 60 trillion in a full-grown adult. The foundation of your baby's body is important for healthy growth. Through classes and individual consultations, let's work together to think about how you can spend your pregnancy to give your baby a solid foundation for healthy growth.

Class for expecting mothers and fathers

The mother's body is connected to the baby's body. During pregnancy, women's bodies change in ways that can and cannot be seen, such as the quantity of blood and hormonal changes, as well as the size of the abdomen.
